Welcome!	Thank you for joining the meeting! We have had quite a few apologies from schools who are starting to be involved in Christmas activities. We will send out the minutes and the presentation we are going to share so that everyone can catch up ahead of our next meeting.
Any updates?	<p>Mrs Andrews asked if all the councillors at the meeting had received their Trust Eco Council badge. Most of the schools had their badges; councillors who had not received them to ask their offices / Headteachers or the staff that support the Trust Council meetings.</p> <p>There were lots of thoughts and updates since our last meeting as we had all been thinking about this year's focus on biodiversity.</p> <p>Godolphin shared the work of their eco club who had been busy planting bulbs and picking up leaves in their grounds Halwin had been talking about different types of waste and thinking about sustainability projects Portreath shared that one of the classes had been planting some new trees on the school grounds Rosemellin spoke about their forest school and were looking at wildlife, bird feeders and their trees Illogan in Geography, some of their learning had been about climate change and the impact it has on different biomes</p>
Rewilding	<p>Mrs Andrews shared a powerpoint (sent out with the minutes) about the idea of re-wilding areas and how we might be able to do this.</p> <p>Our plan is to ask councillors to identify a few different areas of their grounds that think we could give over to wildflowers. We will need to speak to the people who look after our grounds before we do anything but if we can identify some areas in the next couple of months we can hopefully think about scattering wildflower seeds in the Spring.</p> <p>If schools have a map of their grounds to mark good areas on, they can do that or just make some notes about where they think would be good places to 're-wild'</p>
