Dear Stakeholders/Local Community,

In line with the *School Admission Code 2021*, we would like to notify you of the following proposed changes to our 2026/27 Admissions Arrangements for Godolphin School.

# Notification of proposed temporary variation in PAN for 2026/27 for Godolphin School

A temporary reduction in PAN from 15 to 10 is being proposed for Admissions Arrangements for 2026/27 academic year for the reasons set out below:

#### **Current Situation**

Class Structure: Godolphin School currently operates with a 3-class structure:

- Reception/Year 1
- Year 2/3
- Year 4/5/6

**September 2025 Intake:** The school admitted 20 pupils into Reception, exceeding the Published Admission Number (PAN) of 15. This decision was made because:

- The school had available spaces throughout the setting
- Parents had indicated they would submit appeals, which the school was unlikely to win owing to the availability of spaces.

# The Challenge for September 2026

# **Projected Numbers:**

- Through close collaboration with the pre-school, the school was advised that projected numbers for September 2026 would be much lower than the 2025 intake.
- However, applications for places are now anticipated to exceed the 10 available spaces in the youngest children's class.

## Impact on School Organisation

Admitting more than 10 pupils would create significant operational challenges:

#### Class organisation

- Mixed-age arrangements would compromise consistent educational provision
- Managing differentiated teaching across the same year group in different classes would be extremely challenging



### **Curriculum Impact:**

- Complete curriculum restructuring required for different class structure
- Reduced whole-class instruction necessary
- Significant additional differentiation demands on teachers

## The Solution

## Temporarily reducing PAN from 15 to 10 for Reception 2026 intake will:

- Maintain the current class structure
- Avoid the need for complete curriculum restructuring
- Preserve equality of educational opportunity
- Enable effective teaching and learning across all year groups

### **Alternative Provision**

**Sithney School** (another Crofty Education Trust school):

- Located 2.2 miles from Godolphin Cross
- Has capacity to accommodate pupils who don't secure a place at Godolphin Primary
- Ensures families still have access to trust provision
